## Mature women more likely to succeed in business.

Women aged 50 plus are more likely to succeed than their 30-year-old counterparts when it comes to running a small business a recent report has revealed.

- It is confidence rather than capability that holds many women back from starting their own business.
- Many undervalue their business acumen, despite possessing valuable transferable skills and knowledge.
- Existing start-up training often fails to meet the needs of mature women, ignoring the need to improve technological adoption and money mindset.
- Caring responsibilities means that women are typically the 'first port of call' for domestic caring duties. This can impact their business and personal finances and sometimes their own wellbeing.

The reports main conclusion is that the old stereotypes of mature women in business need to be openly challenged.

Financial institutions, banks, lenders, and commercial companies need to be designing products and services that meet the needs of women, acknowledging their journey without disadvantaging them.
